City Council Minutes
May 16, 2022

On this day May 16,2022, at 6:00 pm, Mayor Stephen Lucas called a regular City Council meeting to order with council members Cody Jorgenson, Susan Hubbard, Clara Kay, Greg Branson and Eric Maloy. Greg Branson made a motion to approve temporary housing from 6/1/22 to 9/1/22 for remodeling at 187 Estelle St Hawkins, TX. Eric Maloy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

No action taken for the discussion and approving to hire one part/full time employee for solely maintaining the City Right of ways.

Greg Branson made a motion to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Eric Maloy. The motion passed unanimously.
